

Buprenorphine Waiver Training Schedule

The Drug Abuse Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000) specifies training is necessary for physicians to obtain a waiver to engage in office-based treatment of opioid use disorders using drugs approved by the FDA on Schedules III, IV, and V. This course addresses those requirements using a curriculum approved by CSAT/SAMHSA and ASAM, one of the national organizations named in the DATA 2000 legislation as eligible to prepare and administer these courses.

The course is available in a variety of formats, including half live-half online, entirely live, half live webinar- half online, and all-online. The half and half courses combine 4 hours online and 4 hours live learning to meet the needs of today's busy physicians. Courses can require the online component first OR the live component first (Parts 1 and 2 respectively). Please be sure to check the requirements as there is generally a time limit to complete the course as well.

This course is available now from several organizations. The ASAM Buprenorphine Course for Office-Based Treatment of Opioid Use Disorders has recently been updated to include new delivery formats and an updated evidence-based curriculum designed by national experts. Course participants are exposed to the highest quality, evidence-based practices when using buprenorphine to treat opioid use disorders. The case-based learning formats to show learners how to apply this new knowledge.

Participants of the recognition program may complete any ASAM course at no cost - courses taken through other organizations can be used to fulfill this requirement but pricing is up to the discretion of that organization.

Participants may submit previously acquired CME certificates (from the past 2 years) to fulfill this component.
